DIPLOMA IN GOVERNMENT COURSE A SUCCESS FOR NAVY

The Australian Hydrographic Service recently completed a pilot program in conjunction with Defence Training with the successful staging of a Diploma in Government Course. The program, called "Management Matters Managed Program" ran over 10 weeks and was divided into two elements; management and leadership.

The program aimed to refine, develop and recognise public sector management and leadership skills. The program deals with a range of theoretical and practical skills needed by managers and leaders in the public sector. It looked at such issues as; the ethical and legal basis of public service, the development of workplace leadership, coordinating resources, research and workgroups, providing and evaluating client services, and workplace safety. Two groups, made up of senior to middle management staff from both the APS and the RAN attended.

Some of the students are continuing on with workplace assessments and TAFE-based electives to complete the Diploma in Government.
