3.7.2 Promulgation

- 1. The following wrecks are shown on Australian Navigation Charts:
 - all reported shipwrecks
 - wrecks with protected zones or prohibited areas
 - sites with moorings marking the location
 - sites considered dangerous to safe navigation of ships operating in their normal mode, meaning sites which:
 - lie in shipping channels
 - are considered hazardous to trawl fishing operations
 - are considered hazardous to submarine operations.




