 - (b) All vessels of 60m LOA and above carrying hazardous goods in bulk
 - (c) All passenger vessels of 24m LOA and above carrying more than 12 passengers
- (2) Warships and vessels designated for public service or owned, used or managed by the UAE Government, or any of its public bodies or organisations, are exempt from compulsory pilotage.
- (3) Vessels requiring a Pilot should advise ETA and draught to Khalifa Port Control 12h prior to arrival and confirm ETA 4h prior to arrival at the Pilot boarding position.
