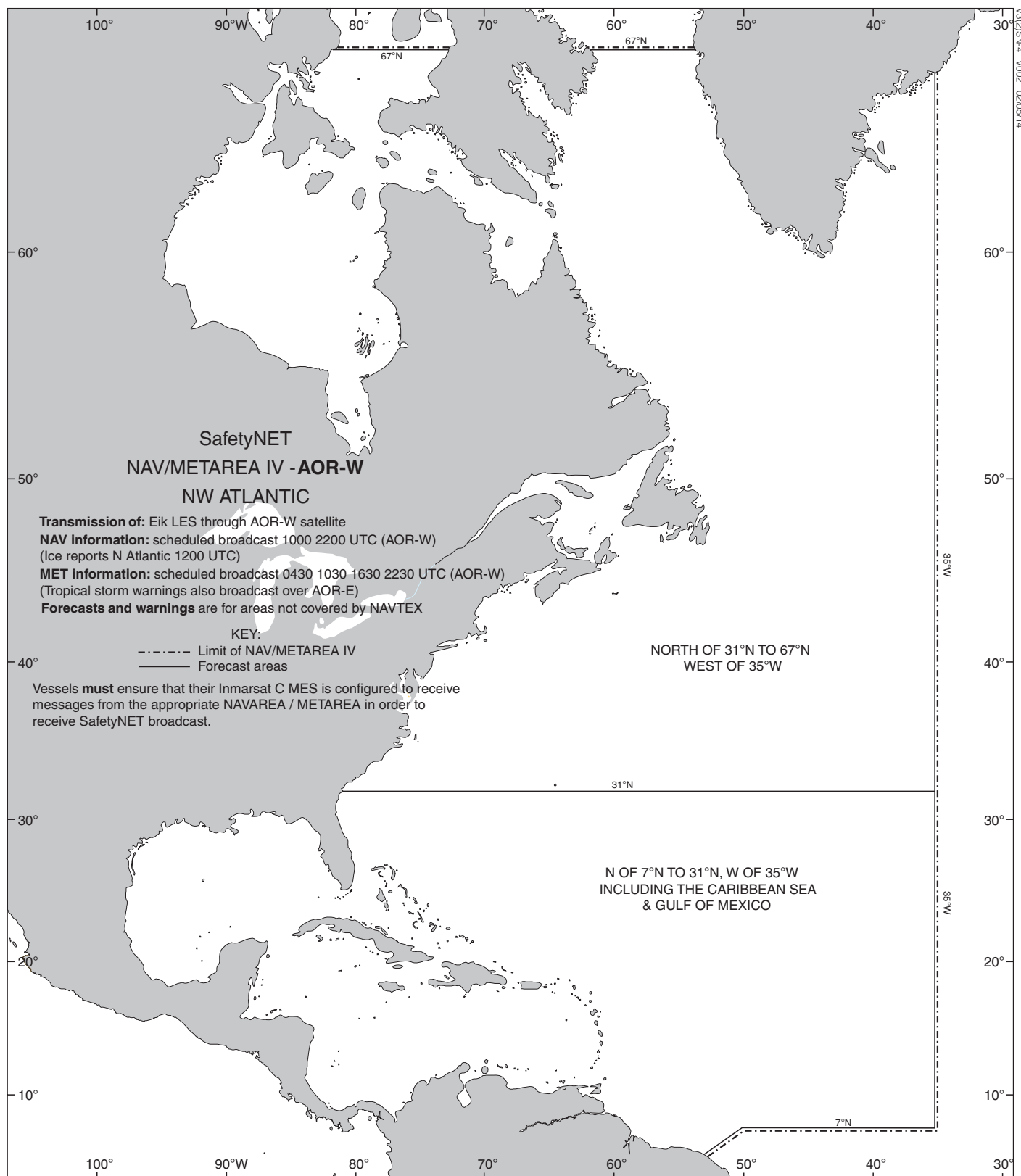
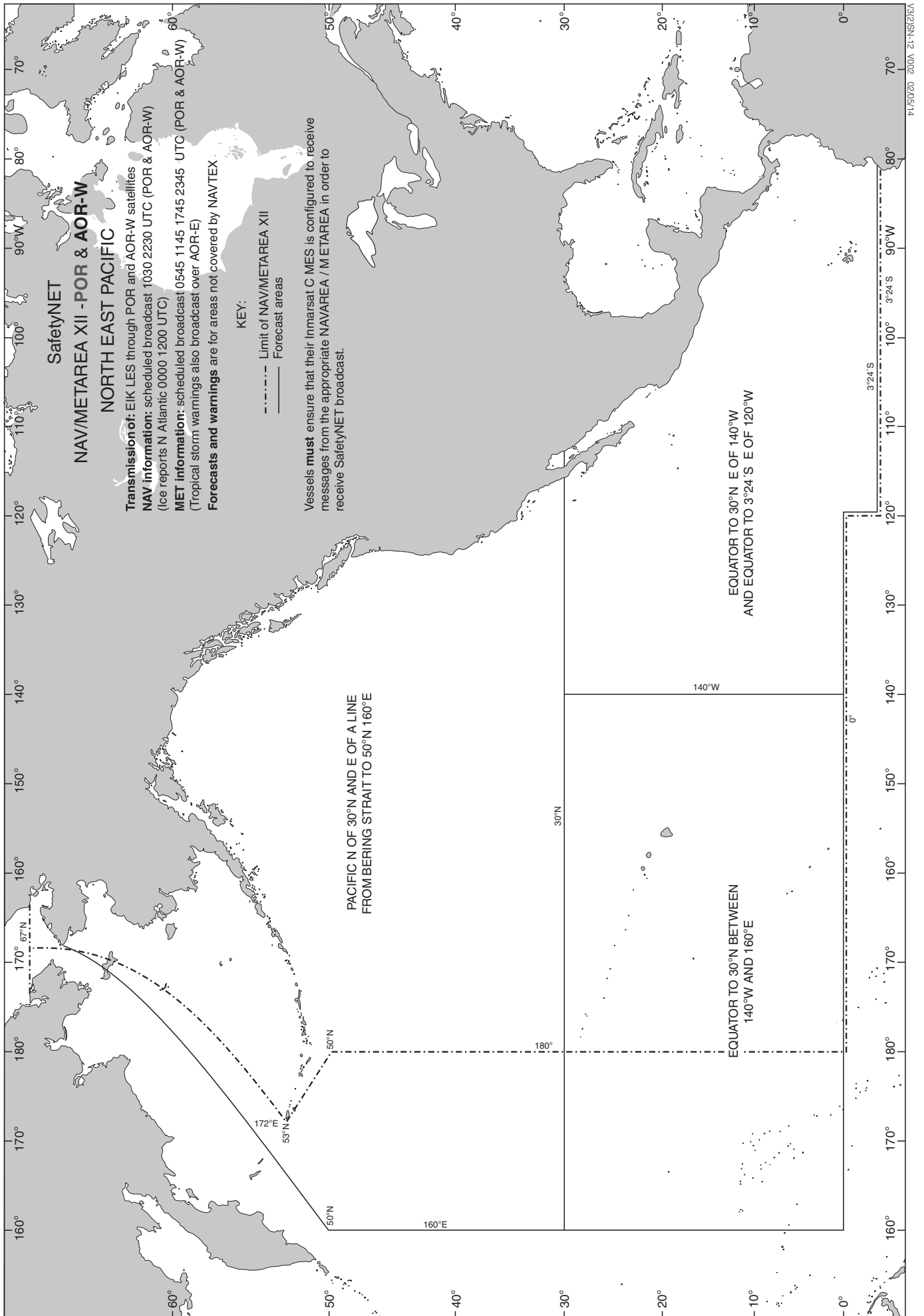
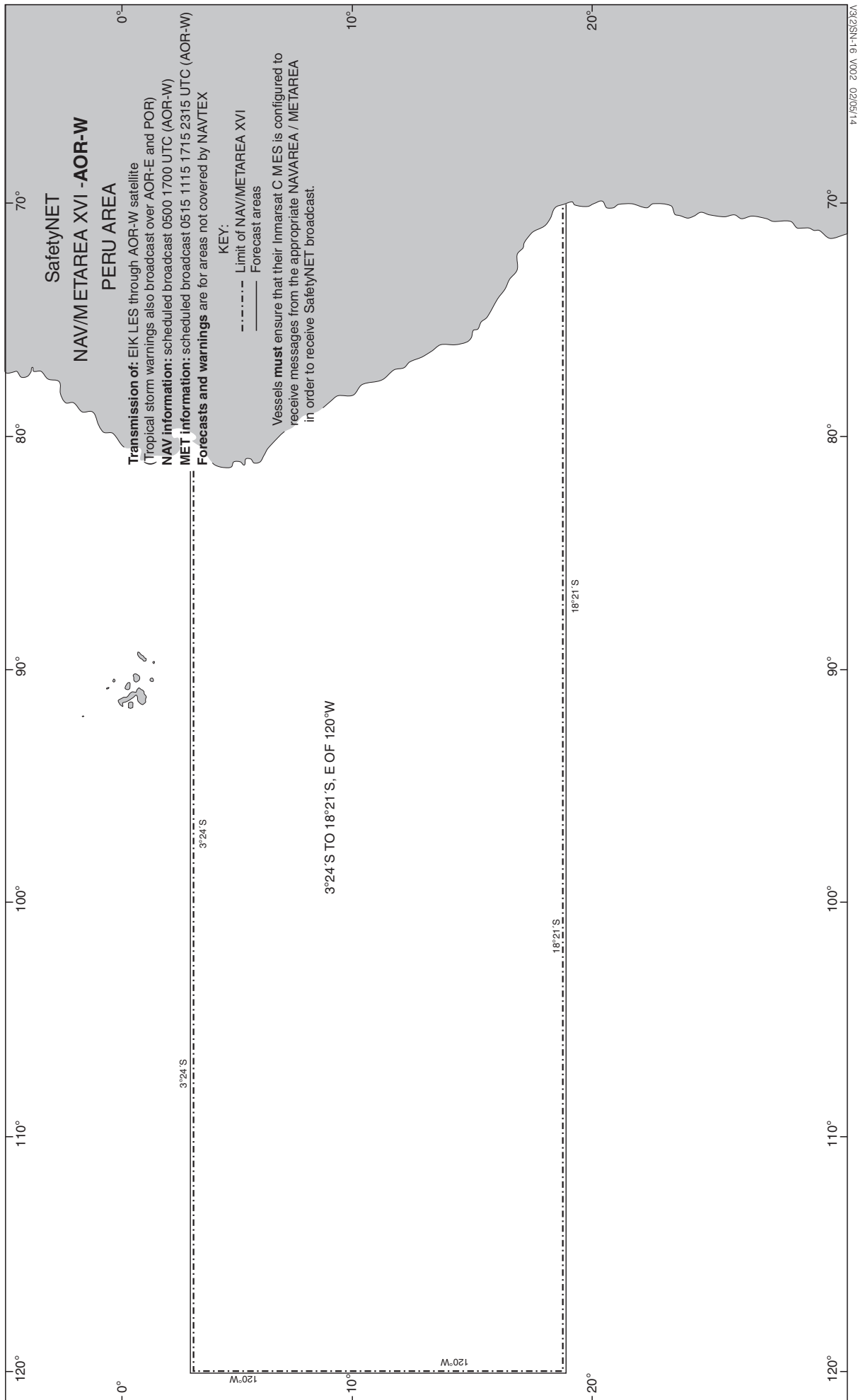

Western Australia – Dampier — Under Keel Clearances

Paragraph 6.127 *Replace by:*

- 1 Masters and Pilots operating within the Port of Dampier are required to calculate Under Keel Clearance (UKC) in the Harbour Channels for arrival and departure, and for the times they are alongside in the Berth Pockets at low water. This must be done as part of the arrival passage planning, or the ship shore check list.
- 2 Minimum permissible UKCs are as follows:

In Harbour Channels, on arrival or departure	Static: 1.0 m or 10% of draught, whichever is greatest. Dynamic: 0.5 m.
In berth pockets	Static: 1.0 m.
Mermaid and King Marine Supply Bases	Static: 0.75 m.
- 3 Where greater UKCs than specified are required, these will be allowed.

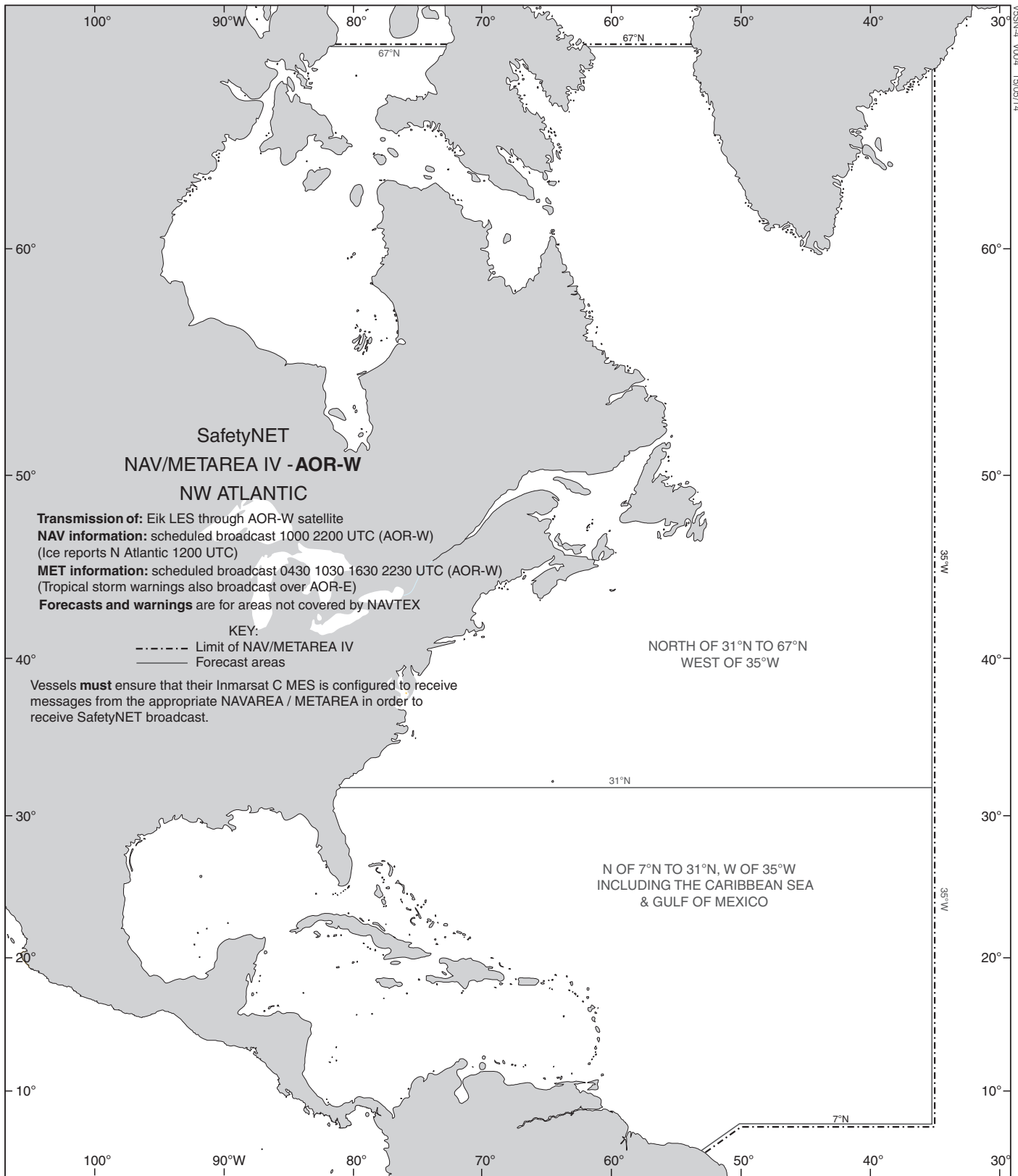

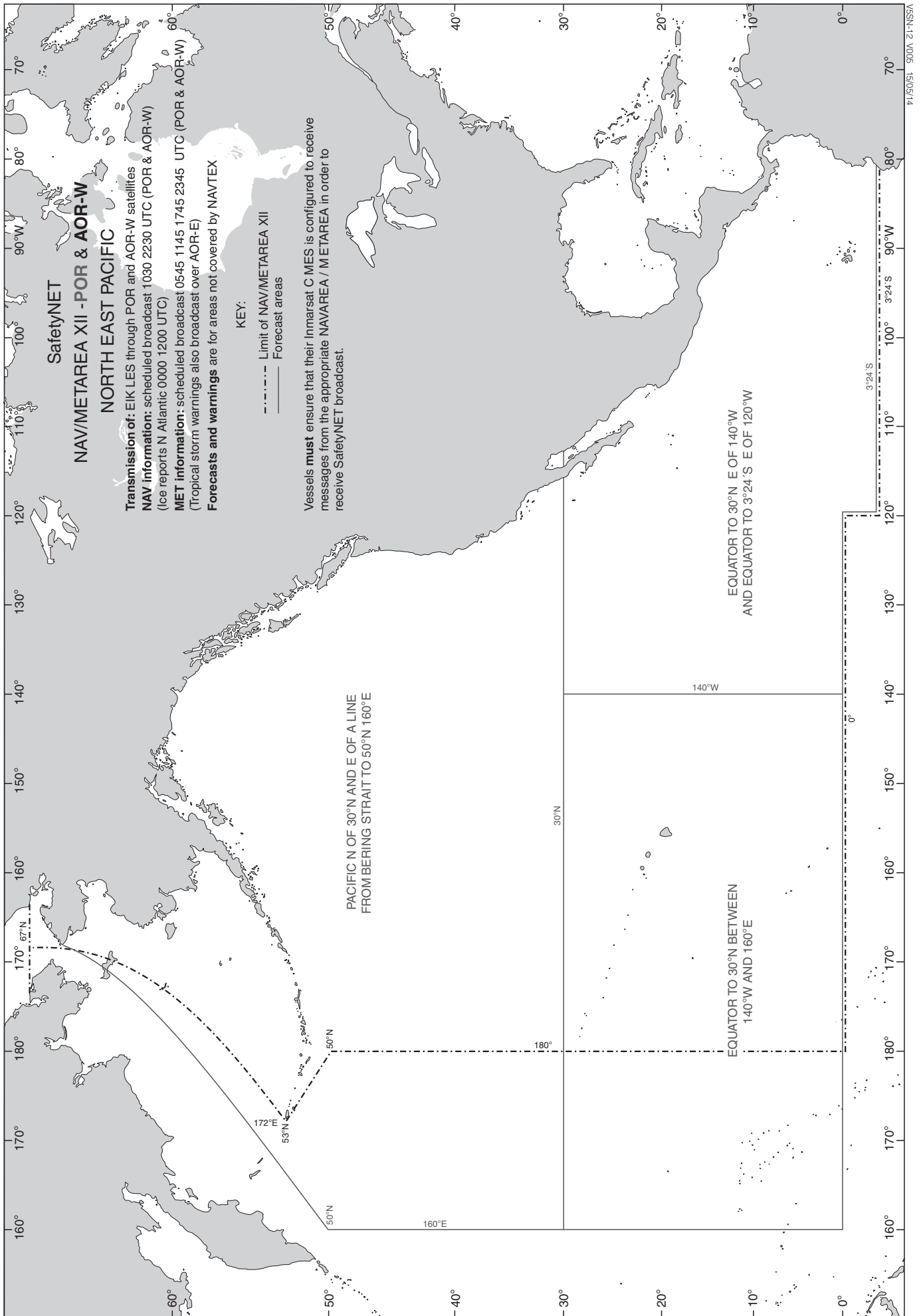
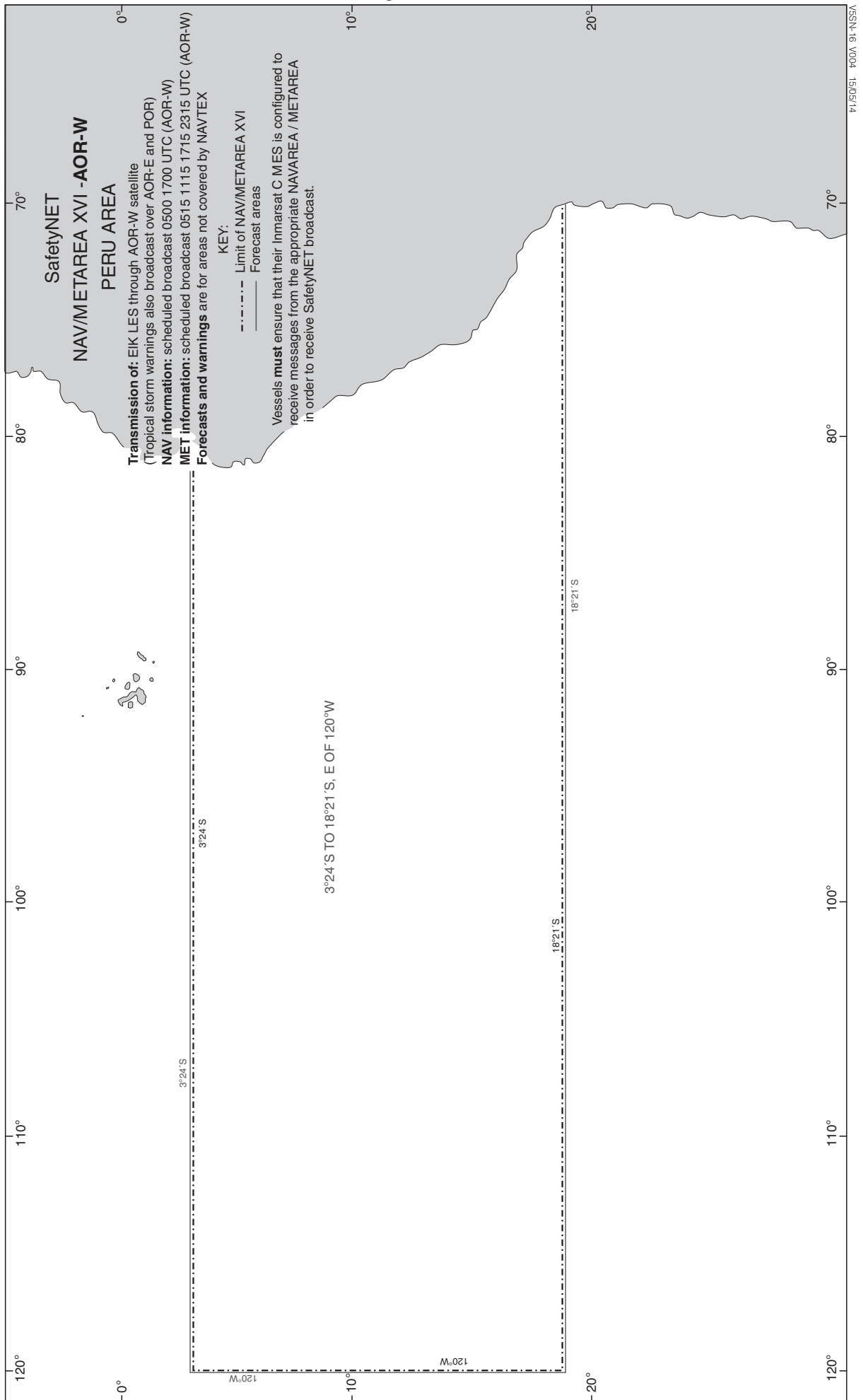
