

What is AusGeoTIFF?

AusGeoTIFF are raster images of the Australian Navigational Chart Series in GeoTIFF format. For more information, see *Product Information*, Brochure 1.

Why are charts updated?

The Australian Navigational Chart Series is continuously updated for 'Notices to Mariners' updates or NtMs. NtM updates include previously uncharted features or altered features that may be hazardous to navigation. However NtM updates can also be of use to non-navigational applications. Some examples of NtM updates include changes to port features due to new construction work & previously uncharted reefs, rocks and shoals.

Do I have to update my images?

AusGeoTIFF update services are entirely optional and may be purchased for all or a selection of the charts in your portfolio.

How are the images updated?

AusGeoTIFF offers two update service options to automatically update your chart images for NtM updates:

- Monthly Update Service
- Periodic Update Service

What is a monthly update service?

If you purchase a monthly update service, each month you will receive a disk containing new images for all the charts in your update service which have changed that month as a result of NtM action. Monthly updates are purchased for a year's duration & are renewable on an annual basis within the term of your licence.

What is a Periodic Update Service?

You may purchase updates to all or part of your *AusGeoTIFF* image portfolio as often as you like during the term of your licence. You will receive

the latest *AusGeoTIFF* images for all the charts you request on disk.

How do I select my update portfolio?

You may select charts for your Monthly or periodic Update Service at any time by contacting the Licensing Manager.

How do I add charts to my AusGeoTIFF image portfolio?

You may add charts to your *AusGeoTIFF* image portfolio at any stage during your licence. However, please note that additional charts will expire on your licence expiry date. Prices for additional charts can be found in *Brochure 4*, *Pricing*.
